The ECHOES two half-day event held in Brussels on the 12-13 December was a great success. Day 1 consisted of setting the context for the Cultural Heritage Cloud with presentations from a variety of organisations involved in the sector. The Keynote presentation by Bart Fransen provided a fascinating insight into the restoration of the Ghent Altarpiece and other works by Jan Van Eyck in the Verona Project and the afternoon concluded with a round table discussion. Day 2 was concerned with how to involve as many Cultural Heritage communities as possible in ECHOES and to encourage their take-up and participation in the Cultural Heritage Cloud.
